\$1k-a-Pay Staff Lottery

The Staff Lottery is a payday draw for a fixed cash prize of \$1,000 tax-free.

To participate: complete, sign and submit this enrollment form to Yarmouth Hospital Foundation. This initiates a \$5.00 deduction from your pay every payday. Participants are eligible to win repeatedly!

Deductions will show on your pay stub and will be included on your T4 as a non-taxable deduction therefore participation in the program is not considered a charitable donation.

You may withdraw at any time by providing two weeks' notice in writing/email to Yarmouth Hospital Foundation.

Funds raised by the lottery will be used to support the work of the foundations at Yarmouth, Shelburne & Digby hospitals.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will my deduction start?

Your deduction (\$5.00 per pay) will start on the pay period of your first eligible draw date.

Who administers the lottery?

The Employee Lottery is administered by staff of Yarmouth Hospital Foundation, none of whom will be allowed to participate due to lottery regulations.

Where will the draw be held?

Draws are held every payday Thursday shortly after 12:00 noon in the cafeteria of Yarmouth Regional Hospital, COVID-19 permitting. Otherwise, they are held in the YHF Office, witnessed and recorded, video stored for 1 year.

How will the ballots be produced?

The NSHA Payroll Department provides Yarmouth Hospital Foundation with a list of employees receiving the lottery deduction on their pay stubs. Ballots are created from this list prior to each draw.

How will I know my name is in the draw? Is the list of participants published?

To ensure that your name will be in the draw, please check to confirm that the lottery deduction is on your pay stub. YHF is not permitted to post the list of participants due to confidentiality regulations.

How will I know who won the lottery?

The name of the lottery winner(s) will be posted on the bulletin board outside of YHF's lobby level office and an All Users email will be sent out the day of the draw. If you are the winner, you will be contacted by YHF staff and notified of your win!

Can I still participate if I am on maternity leave?

Yes, employees who are on maternity leave, long-term disability or educational leave can participate. To do so, contact YHF (details on the other side of this page) and pay for your lottery ticket directly by cash, cheque, credit card or E-Transfer. Please note that for this option, a year's total of \$130.00 is required.

This method of payment also applies to non-salaried physicians, registered volunteers and retired staff who do not have employee numbers.

Can casual employees of NSHA participate in the lottery?

Yes, casual employees can participate. As long as you have an employee number, you can participate.

Also: a casual employee who, on occasion, is not receiving a cheque during a pay period can participate in either the above manner or by dropping off \$5.00 at the offices of Digby, Shelburne or Yarmouth Hospital Foundations by 4 p.m. on the Wednesday before the draw.
